

ADD DETERGENTS. CLOSE THE DOOR AND SELECT THE PROGRAMME

Add detergent as indicated on the front page and as described in

- the chapter "Detergent and Additives" in your Instructions for Use.
- Turn the programme selector to the desired programme and

The display shows the programme duration and the predefined spin speed. The lamp next to the "Start/Pause" button \triangleright " blinks.

SELECT ANY DESIRED OPTION

Push the button of any option desired - the respective indication lights up If the combination of programme and option(s) is not possible, the indication lights switch off automatically. Unsuitable combinations of options are deselected automatically.

"Prewash" button $\langle | \rangle$

- Only for heavily soiled loads (for example sand, granular dirt). Increases the cycle time by approximately 15 min.
- · Do not use liquid detergent for the main wash when selecting "Prewash".

"Rapid" button \ 🖈

- Enables quicker washing by shortening the programme duration.
- · Recommendable for small loads or only lightly soiled laundry.

"Clean +" button

- Choose this option if you use an in-wash additive for stain removal (powder, for example "Vanish") - it will optimize the additive's efficiency to get better wash performance and stain removal.
- Use with maximum load.

- Add an appropriate amount of in-wash additive for stain removal (powder) to the main wash chamber, together with your detergent (only use powder detergent with this option) Respect the manufacturer's dosing instructions.
- May prolong the programme by up to 15 minutes.
- Appropriate for use of stain removers and bleaches on basis. Chlorine or perborate bleaches must not be used

"Cold wash" button 🗂

- Water is heated only up to 20°C. Suitable for delicate laundry items with wash te nperature recommendation of max. 30° on the care label

"Intensive rinse" button

- More water is added and inse cycle is prolonged. This option is particularly suitable for areas with very soft

- "Rinse hold" button
- The laundry remains in the last rinse water without progressing to the final spin cycle to avoid creasing and prevent
- colours from changing. Particularly useful if you want to postpone spinning to a later
- time, or if you want to drain only.

Note: The programme stops to "Rinse hold" at the time the "Rinse hold" light in the programme sequence indication is on. The indication lamp next to the "Start/Pause" button \triangleright " blinks.

Terminate the "Rinse hold" option /:

- Press the "Start/Pause" button > II ; the programme will terminate automatically with the final spin cycle for the present wash programme
- If you do not wish to spin the clothes, turn the programme selector to the "Drain" programme and press the "Start/ Pause" button DI.

"Spin" button 🔘

- · Every programme has a predefined spin speed, press the button if you want to set, diff
- If spin speed "0" is selected, the final spinning is cancelled and the water is drained out only. However, intermediate spin peaks remain during rinne.

START DELAY

allows to run the machine at the consumer's for example at night when electricity is cheaper. Do notwse liquid detergent when activating "Start delay". Select programme, temperature and options.

- Press the "Start delay" button to select the desired delay time between 10 minutes and 23 hours.
- Press the "Start/Pause" button \triangleright ".
- On the display, the start delay symbol and the dot between hours and minutes blink. The countdown of the delay time begins.
- The delay time indication disappears when the programme starts and it is replaced by the remaining programme duration.
- Once having pressed the "Start/Pause" button DII, the delay time can be reduced by pressing again the "Start delay" button.

To cancel the "Start delay"

- ...before you press the "Start/Pause" button \mathbb{P}^{\parallel} : • Turn the programme selector to another position or press the "Reset" button
- ...after having pressed the "Start/Pause" button \mathbb{P}^{\parallel} :
- Press the "Start/Pause" button $\supset II$ the light of the selected start delay goes off. Press "Start/Pause" DI again if you want to start the selected programme immediately.

PROGRAMME START

Open the tap and press the "Start/Pause" button \square ". The indication lamp next to the "Start/Pause" button \square lights up. The programme sequence indicator shows the current programme phase, running from left to right through Wash, Rinse, Drain/Spin.



Before starting and after end of a programme, the lamp lights to show that the door can be opened. As long as a wash programme is running, the door remains locked and must on no account be forced open. In case you have an urgent need to open it during a running programme, refer to "Cancel a running programme before the end".

FAILURE INDICATIONS

In case of any failures or irregularities, consult the "Troubleshooting Guide" in your Instructions for Use.

"Service"

Lighting up of the "Service" indication can be caused by a fault in an electrical component.

"Water tap closed" 😤

The washing machine has no or insufficient water supply; the water tap might be closed or the water inlet hose kinked.

"Clean pump" 🌐

Waste water is not pumped out. The drain hose may be kinked or the filter must be cleaned (see "Cleaning the filter" in your Instructions for Use).

PROGRAMME END

- All the lights of the programme sequence indicator are off, and the "Door open" indication $\widehat{\mathbf{r}}$ lights up.
- I. Turn the programme selector to the "Off/O" position.
- 2. Close the water tap.
- 3. Open the door and unload the machine.
- 4. Leave the door aiar to allow the drum to dry.

CHANGE PROGRAMME AND/OR OPTIONS AFTER PROGRAMME START

- I. Press the "Start/Pause" button \square to pause the programme. The light blinks.
- 2. Select the new programme and, if you want, another spin speed and any options.
- 3. Press the "Start/Pause" button \triangleright " again. The new programme continues at the same position where the previous programme was interrupted. Do not add detergent for this programme.

CANCEL A RUNNING PROGRAMME **BEFORE THE END**

The **"Reset"** button cancels a programme before the end. Press and hold the **"Reset"** button r for a few seconds. Any existing water is drained out. It may last some time until the door can be opened.
